

Bonus part

Bag:

As you now can tell, you've made a little cute bear! Ready with a flower chain around his neck he is going in to the woods to gather some berries. For that he needs a little shoulder bag. This is what we're making now. 😊

To be a part of the giveaway it is not necessary to make this part. This is only an optional bonus part. 😊

Bag:

1: chain 9

2: 1 sc in the second chain for the hook, 6 sc, 3 sc in the last stitch, continue along the other side with 6 sc, and finish off with 2 sc in that last stitch = 18

3: crochet in the back loops only for this round – 1 sc in every stitch = 18

4-8: 1 sc in every stitch = 18 (5 rounds)

Now we're making the flap that goes over the bag. Now you're only going to crochet in half of the stitches of the bag and turn for each round.

9: make 1 sc (this does not count for the end total, it is only to get to the middle of the bag), dec, 5 sc, dec = 7


10-12: 1 chain, turn, 7 sc = 7 (3 rounds)

13: 1 chain, turn, dec, 3 sc, dec = 5


Finish off and fasten the thread on the inside.

Strap:


Start in one side with a slip stitch and make about 40 chains. Try the chains around the bears neck to see if it is long enough to get around. Fasten the row of chains at the other side of the bag with a slip stitch. If you want the strap to be thicker you can crochet your way back to the other side by making 1 slip stitch in each chain.



Round 2: continue along the other side with 6 sc and 2 sc in that last stitch.



Start at one side at the inside of the bag with a sl st to start the strap.



Fasten the row of chains to the other side with a sl st and make sl st's in the chains all the way back.
